Progress Report Process	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PSE is Washington’s largest and oldest utility, serving 1.5 million customers in 10 counties • PSE is a clean energy leader committed to meeting Clean Energy Transformation Act (CETA) obligations • PSE is moving toward a future of diverse, non-emitting resources • Public participation shaped our work in multiple ways for the 2023 Electric Progress Report
Distributed Energy Resources	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PSE has a 20+ year history of partnering with our customers to support new renewable energy, above and beyond state mandates. • PSE’s renewable energy products help customers to directly and indirectly support the advancement of new wind and solar – resulting in over 450 MWs of new capacity.
Resource Plan Modeling Results	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Portfolios modeled must meet CETA commitments, which include eliminating coal-fired resources by 2025, becoming greenhouse gas neutral by 2030 and providing 100 percent renewable and non-emitting electricity by 2045 • PSE incorporated climate change data and electric vehicle forecasts into modeling; PSE is still a winter peaking utility through the planning horizon • The future of electricity is a diversified, reliable portfolio of non-emitting resources • PSE expanded on the 2021 IRP approach to further integrate equity into the process • PSE intends to improve methodology for the 2025 IRP and future CEIP cycles
